Pre-Requisites: There are no pre-requisites.

Discover herbs and herbal medicine for animals. Learn how to identify herbs and how to make and apply herbal treatments to benefit your animals at home and in the animal care workplace.

Topics covered will include:

The history of herbal medicine.

Properties of herbs, how they can be administered and how they affect the animal's system. Identification of weeds and herbs growing in the backyard that can be used in herbal medicine.

Make an herbal ointment and oil, an oatmeal rinse, and a lavender and wormwood spray at the workshop.

With qualifications from the National College of Traditional Medicine in Herbal Medicine, your lecturer will teach you how to keep your pets healthy – by keeping it natural.

Students will need to bring covered shoes, an apron or smock top, 4 glass jars with screw lids, a small plastic spray bottle, and 6 sandwich sized zip lock bags to be able to take home herbal products made at the workshop.
