■ Allan Davies (CFCCQ)

Allan, an all-breeds international judge, has been involved in the Cat Fancy for 26 years. His breed interests include Exotic Shorthair, Persians, Devon Rex and the Bengal. With his wife Gail, they breed under the Gilroy prefix.

He is on several committees within the Cat Fancy and is currently President of CFCCQ.



■ Terry Barrett (QFA)

Terry became involved in the cat fancy in 1968. Terry's breed interests are the Balinese, Siamese, Oriental, Oriental Longhairs and more recently British Shorthairs and he holds two prefixes, Hilo granted in 1969 and Hikatz granted in 2008. Terry has bred and shown Siamese and Orientals over many years and awards achieved include breeding two Cat of Year winners (a Seal Pt Siamese and a Black Oriental) and showing a green-eyed White Oriental to Kitten of Year, along with many Best of Breed awards.



Terry gained his Shorthair (Groups 2 & 3) judge's licence with the Feline Control Council of Queensland in 1986 and transferred to QFA Inc in 2008. He has judged in Queensland, NSW, Tasmania, SA, ACT and NT. Terry enjoys the challenge of judging cats he has not handled before and the joy that is on the face of the exhibitor who owns the Best in Show.

Terry is currently President of Northern Feline Fancy of Qld and is the Club's Delegate to QFA Inc Council. He is also currently President of the Balinese and Siamese Cat Club. Between 1970 and 2004 Terry held positions in FCCQ including President, Vice-President and Treasurer.

Terry still enjoys all shows as you meet some wonderful people and never stop learning from other judges' and breeders' knowledge and experiences.

■ Wendy Hamilton (NSWCFA)

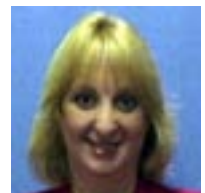
My first purebred cat was, like so many people years ago, a seal point Siamese. Not a showgirl but a wonderful introduction to pedigree cats. After visiting my first cat show, it was the brown Burmese that I fell in love with, so in 1977 I purchased my first breeding girl and registered my Zarlee prefix. I exhibited and bred Burmese of all colours for 10 years, winning Best in Show a number of times. However it was during this time I saw my first Birman cat and I was hooked! So it was in 1982 that a seal point Birman joined my family and that is still my breed today. I am pleased to have achieved Best in Show awards with my Birmans both here and overseas. (Although our home is still ruled by a regal Siamese!)



My love of all cats led me into the realm of judging and in 1997 I attained my Group 1 licence, in 2001 my group 2 licence and this year my group 3 licence. I am proud to be a Life member of the Birman Cat Club of Australia. I have been fortunate to have judged around much of Australia as well as New Zealand and in doing so, have been privileged to have handled some truly beautiful felines.

■ Deborah Cameron (NSWCFA)

I have been involved with the cat fancy for over 30 years having grown up in a family that bred and showed Persians. My love of cats grew and in the late 1980's I started showing and breeding Chinchilla, Shaded Silver and Golden Persians. Dabbling with beautiful Smokes and Himalayans and my commitment by working at shows in various capacities such as Show Manager and Show Secretary, I felt that I needed even more involvement and I gained my Companion Judges license in 2003. Enjoying this new side of judging led to my long term goal in becoming a Judge, obtaining my Group 1 licence in 2006, and my group 3 licence this year.





Currently I am a member of the NSW CFA Inc. Management Committee, and hold the position of Secretary of the NSW Ku-Ring-Gai-Cat Club as well as being on the committee of various local clubs.

In my spare time I work full time in Local Government managing a large team of Community Development Workers and enjoy the company of my cats and dog, Eddie.

■ Sharon Hodge (NSWCFA)

Sharon and her husband Les have been breeding persians and exotics under the Kalanautch prefix for many years and have had considerable success on the show bench. Sharon gained her group 1 judging licence in 2007 and since then has enjoyed judging at many shows.

■ Fiona Mangan (NSWCFA)

Animals have always been important in my life. After growing up in the company of greyhounds, whippets and a succession of cats of varying descriptions, I became interested in cats in a serious way after forming a liaison with my first Abyssinians, a tawny and a silver, in 1989. Initially, it was just an involvement in showing cats. Breeding them soon followed, specializing in Silver Abyssinians under the Nivalis prefix. Today, even though we have a multi-cat household (the numbers always fluctuate), each of them is allotted time according to their need to love and be loved. All cats are special and each is unique, regardless of their origins.



I am a member of a variety of cat clubs and have, for many years, been actively involved with the Abyssinian Cat Club serving in various roles including President, Secretary, Treasurer and Show Manager. For several years I have been active as an approved steward, qualified as a Companion Exhibit Judge in 2003 and as a group 3 Judge in 2009.

■ Lyn Thwaites (NSWCFA)

I have been involved in the cat fancy since 1971 and in that time I have successfully bred and shown Persian cats, and recently Siamese and Orientals, under the Perzeena prefix. I bred the



1985 Longhair RASCC Male Cat of the Year (Db Gd Ch & CCCA Ch Perzeena Drifts Son – orange eyed white Persian) and I have owned other Cats of the Year and numerous Top 5 award winners as well. I have also shown a British Shorthair and a Devon Rex with success on the show bench for both.

In 1995 I was invited to become a Companion Cat Judge. This is an honour which I take very seriously and which I greatly enjoy.

I am actively involved in several clubs, including Kempsey Kat Klub of which I am a Life Member. I have also stewarded for many years and I have worked in the card room and on trophy tables of many affiliate shows throughout my time in the cat fancy. I now live on the Mid North Coast of NSW, in the town of Kempsey, since moving from Sydney in 1995.

■ Margaret Cumming (NSWCFA)

I have always owned Companion Cats and in 1978, with my late husband, ventured into breeding Chinchillas, and Blue, White, Tortoiseshell & Red Persians. I now concentrate on breeding Cream, Blue and Blue/Cream Persians. I have held the positions of Show Secretary & Club Secretary of the Newcastle and Hunter Valley Cat Club. I have assisted in running stewards training classes for the NSW CFA. My love is for all cats.



■ Deborah Thomas (NSWCFA)

Deborah, an experienced steward of many years standing, successfully completed the NSW C.F.A. Companion Judges Course in May 2003. Since then she has enjoyed a number of appointments judging companion exhibits.



Deborah breeds Abyssinians & Somalis under the Nareira prefix, and has had considerable success on the show bench with both of these breeds.

2. **To compete in a show run under NSW C.F.A. show rules and procedures a Companion Exhibit needs to be classified as to:**

◆ **TYPE:**

- **Domestic** – a kitten/cat whose sire & dam are unknown or are both not registered pedigree cats **OR**
- **Household Pet** – a kitten/cat whose sire or dam but not both is registered, or is a pedigree cat which is unregistrable

◆ **COAT PATTERN:** • Solid, • Patterned, or • Patched
Classification needs to be carried out by a panel of 3 judges (one a companion judge, one a pedigree judge, and the third a companion or pedigree judge). The Classification Section of a NSW C.F.A. Inc. Companion Exhibit Classification/Registration Form will be completed by the panel for each exhibit classified and a copy of the form given to the owner of the exhibit.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- ❑ An official NSW C.F.A. entry form must be completed and forwarded. A form accompanies this schedule. As indicated on the form, for each exhibit entered a legible copy of the exhibit's 4 generation pedigree, as issued by a recognised controlling body, must be attached. For each unregistered companion exhibit entered
 - (i) provide details of its type and coat pattern (see information at bottom of page 4)
 - (ii) attach a copy of the exhibit's certificate of sterilisation (desexing) signed by a qualified Veterinary Surgeon
 The summary sheet which accompanies this schedule must be completed and forwarded also.
- ❑ An exhibitor resident in NSW must be a current financial member of NSW C.F.A. Inc. However
 - A new exhibitor resident in NSW may show 3 times as a non-member provided any pedigree exhibit(s) shown is/are registered in the exhibitor's name with NSW C.F.A. Inc. A companion exhibit may be shown 3 times without being registered.
 - An exhibitor resident in another state/territory/country must be a member of a recognised controlling body in that state/territory/country and the exhibit(s) entered registered in the exhibitor's name with that controlling body.
- ❑ Each kitten exhibit must be vaccinated. Exhibitors must produce documentary evidence (valid vaccination certificate) for each kitten and a vaccination shall have been carried out not less than 14 days prior to the date of the show. A reminder that a vaccination certificate is required for each kitten you enter will be on the Confirmation of Entry you will receive.
- ❑ Amendments to Sex/Colour/Titles:
Any change to the sex, colour/pattern or title of an exhibit after an entry has been lodged must be submitted to the Show Secretary together with a copy of the amended Certificate of Registration.
- ❑ All exhibits must have their front & back claws clipped
- ❑ All cats/kittens remain on exhibition in show cages until 4.00 p.m.
- ❑ The Show Entry Clerk reserves the right to transfer exhibits which are incorrectly entered.

- ❑ Exhibitors are reminded:
A Judge or Steward does not have to handle any exhibit showing signs of aggression. Owners have a duty of care not to bench exhibits with a reported history of fractious behaviour. Show Managers and the Show Committee, in consultation with the Show Representative, have the right to require the removal of the latter exhibits from the Show.
- ❑ Returned Cheques: Should any cheque forwarded in payment be returned unpaid, a money order, a bank cheque, or cash will be required to be forwarded immediately to ensure acceptance of entry. Any costs incurred by the Club in such a circumstance shall be paid by the exhibitor before the entry is processed.
- ❑ Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the venue.
- ❑ Only Oz-Pet or paper litter may be used at the venue.

NSW C.F.A. Inc. Members & Associate Members Cat/Kitten of the Year Awards

A cat/kitten may accumulate points for a Members or Associate Members Cat/Kitten of the Year Award only whilst it is in the ownership* of a financial member of The NSW Cat Fanciers' Association Inc.

Note that:

- (i) should an owner become a member of the Association after the commencement of the calendar year, ie after 1st January, a cat/kitten owned by the new member will be eligible for the awards **but points will accumulate only from the date that the membership application is processed by the Association's office.**
- (ii) if during the year ownership of a cat/kitten is transferred from a financial member to a new owner who is not a member, the cat/kitten's ownership by a financial member will be deemed to be continuous provided a membership application from the new owner is received by the Association's office within 4 weeks of the transfer as recorded by the NSW C.F.A.

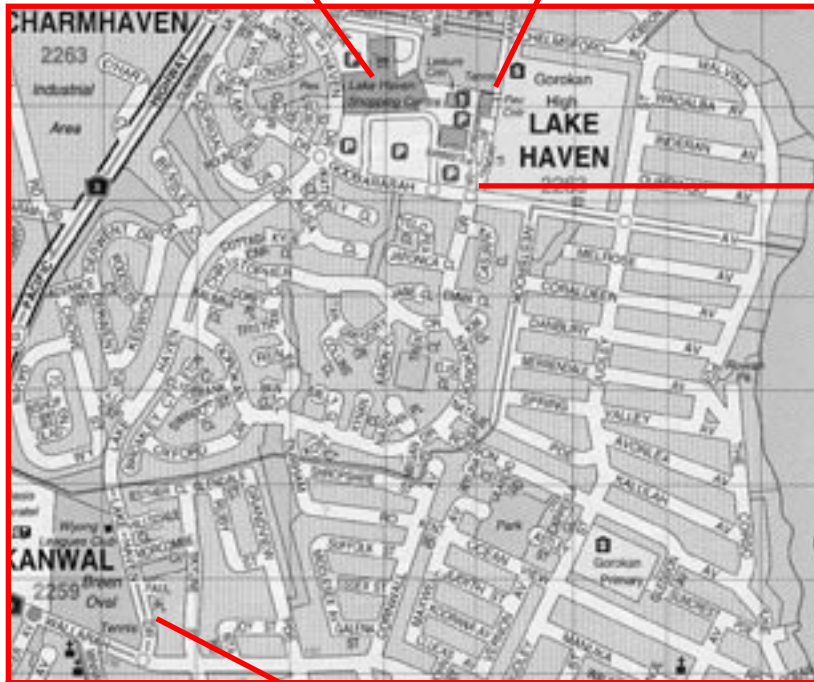

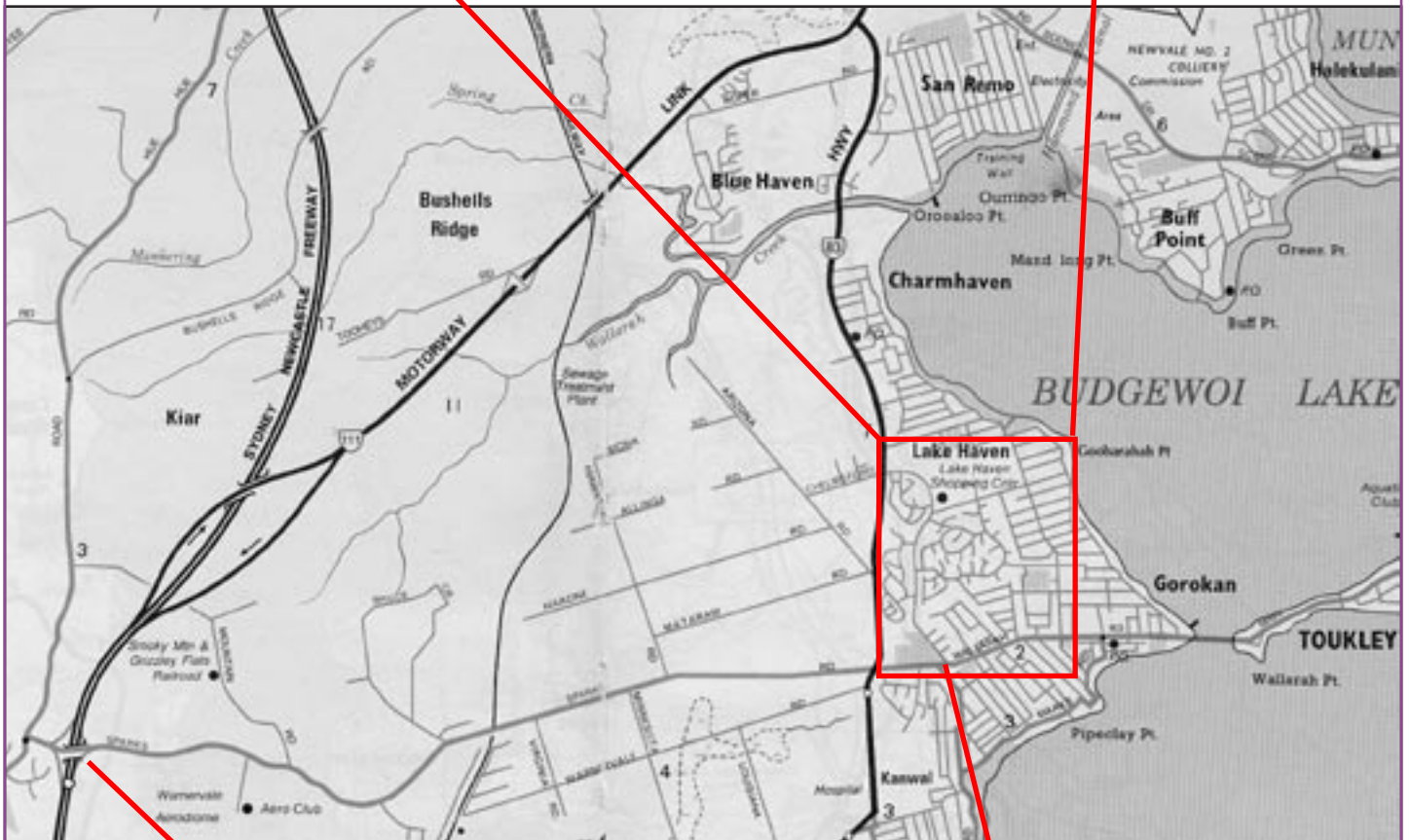
