Returned cheques: Should any cheque be returned to the club unpaid, a money order, cash or a bank cheque will be required immediately to ensure the entry is accepted. Any cost incurred shall be paid by the exhibitor before entry is processed.

EXHIBITS All exhibitors resident in NSW must be current financial members of NSWCFCA. New exhibitors resident in NSW may show 3 times as non-members provided their exhibits are registered in their name with the NSWCFCA. An exhibitor in another state must be a member of a controlling body recognised by CCCA or ACF and the exhibits must be registered in the exhibitor's name with that controlling body.

ALL CATS must be entered in an Open Class plus a sideclass.

CLAWS must be clipped front and back or you run the risk of being disqualified from competition.

ALL KITTENS must be entered in an Age Class plus a sideclass.

ALL KITTENS must have a current vaccination certificate, dated no later than 14 days prior to the show.

No kitten under 10 weeks may be exhibited. The 5 day rule applies for this show.

Each exhibit must be inspected by and pass the Veterinary Officer's inspection before being allowed to be benched in the show. Exhibitors are to handle their own cats at the vetting table.

EXHIBITORS are required to present a vaccination certificate in respect of each kitten entered. Exhibits must remain on show until 4pm. unless a letter is sent to the Show Secretary 7 days before the show.

NB A Judge or Steward does not have to handle any exhibit showing signs of aggression.

INFORMATION FOR COMPANION CAT EXHIBITORS

All Companion exhibits over the age of 6 months must be desexed. For an unregistered Companion Exhibit a copy of the exhibit's certificate of sterilization, signed by a qualified veterinary surgeon, must accompany the entry.

Companion exhibits are divided into Domestic and Household Pet sections.

Domestic – both parents not pedigreed or both unknown.

Household Pet –one parent is pedigreed or it is a pedigreed cat that cannot be registered.

Companion exhibits may be shown for the first time without classification and 3 times without registration.

You need to bring your exhibit to the show hall on Saturday 29th August 2008, between 7am -8.30am for the mandatory free veterinary inspection of all show exhibits.

KITTENS(under 9 months) are required to have a current vaccination certificate which must be presented to the veterinary officer in attendance. Please make sure that your pet is clean, with no sign of fleas, ear mites or ringworm.

Your cat must be carried into the show hall in a secure carry cage – not a cardboard box.

You will need white curtains, a white towel for the cage base during the judging, plus a litter tray with paper litter, water bowl and feed bowl for after judging is finished. Remember to clip all their claws.

You must be a member of the NSW CFA Inc for TOP 5 points to be allocated for the Cat/kitten of the Year points. If you wish to join please contact the NSW CFA office 02 98346577 for a membership package.

ENTRIES All entries must be submitted on the official NSW CFA Entry Form together with a clear copy of each exhibit's registration certificate in the name of the exhibitor as owner. For interstate exhibitors where the registration certificate does not include a 4 generation pedigree, then a 4 generation pedigree must be provided showing the breeds and colours of all forebears.

AMENDMENTS TO SEX/COLOUR/TITLES.

Any change to the sex, colour/pattern or title of an exhibit after an entry has been lodged must be submitted in writing to the Show Secretary with a copy of the amended certificate of Registration.

N.B Children are not permitted to roam the school grounds and the Children's playground equipment is not to be used. We are asked to show due care to the surrounding gardens, tables and chairs.

The use of Talcum Powder is strictly prohibited within the hall.

Smoking is also strictly prohibited inside the hall, but permitted outside the school grounds.

All ribbons, rosettes, challenge cards and prizes are the responsibility of the exhibitor and will not be replaced if they disappear.

Exhibitors are reminded to check that your cats' registration papers are correct - particularly that the desexed cats/kittens are recorded as neuters or spays - not entire.

CAT/KITTEN OF THE YEAR AWARDS

To be eligible for Cat of the Year awards, an exhibit must be in the continuous ownership of a financial member throughout the year. Points are awarded based on the Top Five results at a show. 1st - 10pts; 2nd - 7 pts; 3rd - 4pts; 4th - 2 pts; 5th - 1 pt.

Note 1. Where an owner becomes a member after the start of a calendar year, points will only accumulate from the date the membership application is processed by the office of the NSWCFI Inc.

Note 2. If during the year a cat is transferred to a new owner who is not a member, the cat's ownership by a financial member will be deemed continuous provided a membership application from the new owner is received and recorded by the office of the NSWCFI Inc within 4 weeks of the date of transfer, otherwise note 1 will apply.

**JOINT OWNERS MUST BE FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF THE ASSOCIATION.*

TOP 5 MALE, FEMALE, NEUTER AND SPAY CATS AND
MALE, FEMALE & DESEXED KITTENS will be judged in 3 rings.

"Challenges" in each ring may be awarded to adult cats, entire and desexed and "Best in Sections" to kittens, where the exhibits reach the standard required by the judge. N.B. Best in Section and Challenge ribbons will only be given to winning exhibits upon request.
