COMPANION CAT REGISTRATION APPLICATION

Companion Cats must be described prior to Registration with the NSWCFCA, this may be carried out on the top half of this form.

Common sense should be applied to the obvious - a black and white cat is just that, and requires no fancy consultation, however, many Companion Cats combine colour and pattern in all sorts of unusual combinations, so that an agreement is required between three (3) Judges (1 pedigree, 1 domestic, the third either) on how the cat is to be described. This remains the description of the Companion Cat for life.

The description of the cat should be made on the first occasion that the Companion Cat is exhibited at a NSWCFCA Show.

REGISTRATION
A Companion Cat may be exhibited three (3) times at a NSWCFCA show without being registered with the NSWCFCA. This enables the exhibitor to discover whether they, and more importantly the cat, enjoy the exhibiting and judging process.
Prior to entry to a fourth NSWCFCA show, this completed form must be returned to the NSWCFCA, PO Box 379 ST MARYS NSW 1790 accompanied by the fee of \$14.00.

A Registration Certificate will be returned to the owner, upon which there will be a Registration Number, which must be used on all subsequent Show Entry forms. The Registration Certificate will also be required to be submitted to the NSWCFCA when applying for a title update for the cat.
