## NSW C.F.A. Inc. Members & Associate Members Cat/Kitten of the Year Awards

A cat/kitten may accumulate points for a Members or Associate Members Cat/Kitten of the Year Award only whilst it is in the ownership\* of a financial member of The NSW Cat Fanciers' Association Inc. Note that:

(i) should an owner become a member of the Association after the commencement of the calendar year, ie after 1st January, a cat/kitten owned by the new member will be eligible for the awards but points will accumulate only from the date that the membership application is processed by the Association's office.

(ii) if during the year ownership of a cat/kitten is transferred from a financial member to a new owner who is not a member, the cat/kitten's ownership by a financial member will be deemed to be continuous provided a membership application from the new owner is received by the Association's office within 4 weeks of the transfer as recorded by the NSW C.F.A.

\* *joint owners must each be financial members of the Association*

### information for companion exhibitors

- A **Companion Kitten/Cat** is one which is of unknown ancestry, a mixed breed, part pedigreed or a pure breed which is not able to be registered in the usual group.
    - A Kitten is one over 10 weeks of age & under 9 months of age.
    - A Cat is one 9 months of age and over.
  - To be eligible for showing a companion cat must be desexed. A companion kitten over the age of 6 months must be desexed.
  - For the purposes of judging an Unregistered Companion Kitten/Cat will be classified on the basis of the information supplied, as:
    - A **Domestic** kitten/cat is one whose sire & dam are unknown, or are both not registered, or both are not registered pedigree cats, or a
    - A **Household Pet** kitten/cat is one whose sire or dam but not both is registered, is a pedigree cat which is unregistrable, or is an unregistered pedigree cat, being part of a registered litter, which has been desexed and sold as Pet only.
- A Domestic kitten/cat will be classified as to Coat:
- A **Patched** Coat is any coloured coat WITH white (ie, black & white, etc.)
  - A **Patterned** Coat is any coat pattern WITHOUT white (ie: tabby or tortoiseshell, etc.)
  - A **Solid** Coat is one colour

## SHOW CAGES

### Show Supplied Cages

These are VEBO metal cages. These cages are of slightly larger width than the normal show supplied cardboard sided cages. **Your usual single and double curtains will fit these cages**

**SINGLE** – front Width 60cm(24”) X Depth 45cm(18”) X Height 52cm(20”)  
same width size as “OWN61”

**DOUBLE** – front Width 76cm(30”) X Depth 50cm(20”) X Height 57cm(22”)  
same width size as “OWN76”

### Exhibitor Owned Cages:

These are allowed and must comply with the approved standards and sizes as listed below. No other size own cages are allowed. Such cages shall be of a wire mesh type construction with one or two doors. No top opening cages permitted.

Each own cage must be fitted with suitable waterproof and opaque (non-see through) solid barriers on both sides and back to prevent direct contact between benched cats.

**If you are to use an own cage for an exhibit please circle the correct cage code on the entry form**

**OWN61** – a cage of front Width approx. 61cm(24”) or just less

**OWN69** – a cage of front Width approx. 69cm(27”) or just less, but longer than 61cm

**OWN76** – a cage of front Width approx. 76cm(30”) or just less, but longer than 69cm

As usual, a hire fee of \$5.00 applies for a Show Supplied Double cage, and no fee for a Show Supplied Single cage.

No fee applies for an Exhibitor Owned Cage.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- ❑ An official NSW C.F.A. entry form must be completed and forwarded.
- ❑ For each exhibit entered a legible copy of the exhibit's 4 generation pedigree, as issued by a controlling body recognised by CCCA or ACF, or by ANCATS, must be attached.
- ❑ **The summary sheet** which accompanies this schedule must be completed and forwarded also.
- ❑ An exhibitor resident in NSW must be a current financial member of a controlling body recognised by CCCA or ACF, or by ANCATS. However
  - A new exhibitor resident in NSW may show 3 times as a non-member provided any exhibit(s) shown is/are registered in the exhibitor's name with NSW C.F.A. Inc.
  - An exhibitor resident in another state/territory/country must be a member of a controlling body recognised by CCCA or ACF in that state/territory/country, or by ANCATS, and the exhibit(s) entered registered in the exhibitor's name with that controlling body.
- ❑ All exhibits must conform to CCCA Breed Standards. Breeds & colours not included in the CCCA Breed Standards are not eligible to be entered.
- ❑ Any amendment to the title, sex, and/or colour classification of an exhibit after entry has been lodged **MUST** be submitted in writing, **accompanied by a copy of the amended Certificate of Registration**, to the Show Entry Clerk **not later than 1 week prior to the show date**, unless prior arrangement has been made with the Entry Clerk to provide the changes at a later date. **No changes will be made to the catalogue or judging slips on the day of the show.**
- ❑ **Veterinary Inspection:**

Each exhibit must be inspected by and pass the veterinary officer's inspection before being allowed to be benched in the show. Exhibitors are to handle their own exhibits at the veterinary inspection table.

**Each kitten exhibit** must have had at least one Feline-3 vaccination not less than 14 days prior to the Show. The first Feline 3 vaccination must have been administered by a qualified veterinary practitioner.

An exhibitor must produce to the Veterinary Officer **documentary proof of vaccination (valid vaccination certificate)** for all kitten exhibits owned by the exhibitor. A photocopy is acceptable providing it identifies the kitten in question and is a copy of the complete certificate. Failure to do so by a NSWCFA member exhibitor may result in rejection of the exhibit(s) for that show, and if not rejected the exhibitor is required to email a copy of the certificate to the NSWCFA office within 2 working days of the

show. Failure by a non NSWCFA member to provide a valid vaccination certificate will result in the rejection of the exhibits.

- ❑ All exhibits must have their front & back claws clipped
- ❑ **ONLY PAPER LITTER MAY BE USED**
- ❑ **All cats/kittens must remain on exhibition in show cages until 4.00 p.m. unless permission to leave early has been granted by the Show Floor Manager prior to the show.**
- ❑ The Show Entry Clerk reserves the right to transfer exhibits which are incorrectly entered.
- ❑ Returned Cheques: Should a cheque you forward in payment be returned unpaid you will be contacted and required (a) to make an immediate Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) to the Club's account and (b) to inform the Show Entry Clerk a.s.a.p. after this has been done. Once it has checked that the payment has been credited to the Club's account your entry will be confirmed.
- ❑ Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the venue.
- ❑ **Cancellations** We ask for your co-operation in notifying the Show Secretary of cancellations before 12.00 noon on the Friday before the show (if possible)
- ❑ The use of Talcum Powder is strictly prohibited within the Venue.
- ❑ **Exhibitors are reminded:**

A Judge or Steward does not have to handle any exhibit showing signs of aggression. Owners have a duty of care not to bench exhibits with a reported history of fractious behaviour. Show Managers and the Show Committee, in consultation with the Show Representative, have the right to require the removal of the latter exhibits from the Show.
- ❑ Challenge/Award of Merit Cards will be completed by each judge after their judging in a bay is concluded. These and award cards will be placed on cages after all judging in a bay is concluded. All such cards and trophies placed on cages are the responsibility of the exhibitor and will not be replaced should they go missing.
- ❑ Best of Breed, Challenge and Best in Section ribbons will not be awarded
- No exhibit is permitted to leave the show hall until the conclusion of the show without the consent of the show floor manager.
- No flash cameras are to be used within the show hall without the permission of the show floor manager.

For your cat's comfort during travel and benching, it is advisable not to feed them breakfast on the morning of the show.



## JUDGES' PROFILES



### Hayley Boam CCA-AFC

I have always had animals of some kind while growing up. Over the years we have had many breeds of dogs and many different Siamese.

In 1987 I acquired my first Cornish Rex after losing my Siamese - Cleo. We came home with a kitten - Mr. Spock. After 6 months Dad asked if we were getting another one. Mom said if we get another one I would like to have a litter or two. Well to be eligible for a breeding cat I was told one must show and prove they want to improve the breed. So off I went to the shows. In 1990 I got my first breeding pair of crex and the **Reclusive** cattery was born. It was all uphill from there. The show bug got me and I put allot of time into the fancy.

I became a member of CCA (The Canadian Cat Association). I have now been a member for 30 consecutive years with my mother Maureen.

I have imported crex from all over to improve the lines and widen the gene pool. They have come from New Zealand, Austria, Russia, Israel, USA & other parts of Canada With my own breeding *Almond Joy* was best cat in Canada for the 2012-2013 show season. The following season *Astrid* again my own breeding was number one cat in Canada. The 2014/2015 season *Pepper* came in as second best cat in Canada, but my kitten *Reese's Pieces* became best kitten in Canada that year.

After showing I decided to clerk at the shows, and then Master clerk. I then found myself entering the judging program. I have been a CCA judge for over 10 years now. I also have served on the Board of directors off and on over the years. I was on the Ethics Committee, Clerking Committee & the tech committee. I have been breed secretary for the crex for the last 10 years.

We are sort of famous as well. Our cats have done a Stanley Steamer commercial back in 2001. <http://www.ask.com/youtube?q=stanley+steamer+commercial+with+cats&v=A5lbAykQVSk&qsrc=472>

We were the civet cat that bit the chef at the beginning of the movie Plague City Sars in Toronto. Done in 2005

But apart from the cats I have a full time job. I work for The Canadian Kennel Club registering purebred dogs. I have worked there this July for 28 years



### Harley DeVilbiss TICA

Harley is an Approved Allbreed judge & has been a TICA Judge since 2003.

*"I always thought that it would be a fun thing to keep up with my judging. At the current time (October 2016)*

*I have judged over 61,000 cats at over 400 shows in all*

*regions of TICA all over the world.. North, Central, and South America, Europe, Asia, and of course Australia and New Zealand are places I have been fortunate enough to judge.*

*I also track the number of miles flown(1,017,326), driven(48,186), planes traveled on(945), and amount of time away judging (shockingly that number is just over 2.15 years "on the road"). Sometimes we just don't realize it!"*

Harley started showing with his parents in the early 1990's with Manx and Cymrics under the cattery name *MinusDeTails*. With their success came an increased desire to be involved in the association.

His mother was already a judge and became president of TICA. His parents' love of TICA and their love of showing world-renowned Cymrics and Manx rubbed off on Harley so he decided to follow his mother's lead and become a judge.

He decided to distinguish himself from their show career and struck out on his own with British Shorthairs and HMS Brits was born. He has enjoyed great success with his British and continues to breed and show still today.

*"I believe in showing and judging as it keeps me grounded and constantly learning about my breed as well as being able to readily speak with exhibitors about their own breeds."*



### Luiz Paulo Faccioli TICA

Luiz Paulo was born in 1958 in Caxias do Sul, Rio Grande do Sul, Brazil. He attained Allbreed judge status with Federação dos Criadores de Gatos do Brasil in 1992, and became a TICA

(The International Cat Association) judge in 1993. TICA Approved Allbreed Judge status was attained in 2000.
