NB: All Companion Exhibits **MUST** be entered in their **AGE** (kittens) or **OPEN** (Adult) Class. Entry for Companions is a **BLOCK ENTRY** (ie exhibits judged three times in Open/Age Classes and Purrsonality Class).

DON'T FORGET *The “O GENE” SPECIALTY RING* is open to **all** red, cream, all tortoiseshell, blue tortoiseshell (intermingled), chocolate tortoiseshell, lilac tortoiseshell, all tortoiseshell bicolours (all tortie & white), all tortoiseshell tabby, red, cream and all tortoiseshell and tortoiseshell-tabby bicolours, all tortoiseshell points, red/cream/all tortoiseshell smokes, red and cream tabbies and all red/cream tipped (cameos) and shaded. This Specialty Ring will offer Challenges to entire and desexed adults and Best in Sections to kittens. Class numbers are the same as Open/Age Classes but please put **“O GENE”** onto your entry form so that we know you wish to be entered in the extra ring for your eligible exhibits.

This ring is also available for the Companion Section. The Companion “O Gene” ring will be judged separately from the Pedigree Section “O Gene” Ring and offers a Top 10 “O Gene” Ring prize and Award of Merit (as in “O Gene” ring for Pedigree Section).

RING 4 will be FREE to all exhibitors, therefore no prizes will be awarded in this Ring. Top 5 points, Challenges, Award of Merits, Best in Sections will be awarded as normal and will count towards all titles.

TROPHIES, CARDS AND RIBBONS: Exhibitors are reminded that all trophies, ribbons and cards left on cages are the responsibility of the exhibitor and will not be replaced should they go missing.

CATALOGUES: To be ordered with show entry – no exceptions to this rule. There will be NO CATALOGUES for sale on the day of the show.

RECEIPT OF ENTRY: Please include a stamped addressed envelope with your entry.

SHOW CLOSURE: **The club requires that cats remain on exhibition until 4.00pm.** Any exhibitor or person wishing to take an exhibit from the Show Hall prior to this time **MUST** write, requesting permission, seven (7) days before the show date and on show day **MUST BE** escorted from the hall by the Show Manager, Show Secretary or Show Official. Permission **WILL NOT** be given on the day of the show.

INTERSTATE EXHIBITORS: Please note that the 5 day rule applies for this show. For interstate exhibits, please forward a copy of pedigree with entry.

Please leave your rooms in the order that they were in before your arrival as it may jeopardize the Klub's use of these motels in the future. INFORMATION FOR NEW COMPANION EXHIBITORS

You need to bring your exhibit/s to the Show Hall on Saturday, 27 May, 2017 between 7.00 to 8.30am for the mandatory free veterinary inspection of all show exhibits.

Your kitten exhibit/s are required to have a current vaccination certificate, which must be presented to the veterinary officer in attendance. Please make sure your pet is clean, with no sign of fleas, as this inspection is mandatory but is free to all exhibitors. The veterinary officer will check your pet to make sure it is healthy with no sign of cat flu, fleas, ear mites or ringworm.

Your exhibit/s must be carried into the show hall in a secure carry cage – NOT a cardboard box or similar, which is NOT a secure container for a cat or kitten. You will also need a white towel or blanket for your exhibit/s to sit on in the cage during judging and you will also need a small litter tray, litter and water bowl (white or clear containers only) for your exhibit's comfort during the day.

You must be a member of NSW CFA Inc for Top 5 points to be allocated for Cat and Kitten of the Year points (pedigree and companion sections). If you have not joined yet, please contact the office on 02 9834 6577 for a membership package.

Companion Exhibits are divided into Domestic and Household Pets Sections. DOMESTIC – both parents not pedigreed or unknown. HOUSEHOLD PET – one parent pedigreed or a pedigreed cat that cannot be registered. To be eligible for showing, a Companion Cat **must be** desexed. Companion Kitten exhibits **over the age of 6 months must be desexed** (as per Show Procedure 3.9).

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION – SPECIAL EXHIBITOR AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

MEMBERSHIP STATUS

All exhibitors resident in NSW must be current financial members of NSWCFCA or a financial member of CatsNSW or ANCATS when the show is an Open Entry show. New exhibitors resident in NSW may show 3 times as non-members provided their exhibits are registered in their name with the NSWCFCA.

An exhibitor resident in another state must be a member of a controlling body recognised by CCCA or ACF (or ANCATS when the show is an Open Entry show), and the exhibits must be registered in the exhibitor's name with that controlling body.

ENTRIES

All entries must be submitted on the current official NSW CFA Entry Form together with a clear copy of each exhibit's registration certificate in the name of the exhibitor as owner.

For interstate exhibitors where the registration certificate does not include a 4 generation pedigree, then a 4 generation pedigree must be provided showing the breeds and colours of all forebears.

RETURNED CHEQUES

Should any cheque be returned unpaid, a money order, cash or bank cheque will be required to ensure that the entry is processed. The exhibitor will pay any costs incurred by the Club for a returned cheque.

AMENDMENTS TO SEX/COLOUR/TITLES

Any change to the sex, colour/pattern, or title of an exhibit after an entry has been lodged must be submitted 1 week prior to the show date in writing to the Show Secretary with a copy of the amended Certificate of Registration; otherwise the change will not be accepted.

No changes will be made to the judging slips on the day of the show.

CLAWS TO BE CLIPPED

The front and back claws of each exhibit must be clipped.

VETERINARY INSPECTION

Each exhibit must be inspected by and pass the Veterinary Officer's examination before being allowed to be benched in the show. Exhibitors are to handle their own cats at the vetting table.

VACCINATION OF KITTENS

All kittens must be vaccinated. Exhibitors must produce documentary evidence (valid vaccination certificate) for each kitten exhibit and a vaccination shall have been carried out not less than 14 days prior to the date of the show.

AGGRESSIVE EXHIBITS

A Judge or Steward is not required to handle any exhibit showing signs of aggression. Owners have a duty of care not to bench any exhibit that has a reported history of fractious behaviour. The Show Manager and Show Committee in consultation with the Show Representative may require the removal of any such exhibit from the show.

NSWCFCA CAT/KITTEN OF THE YEAR AWARDS

To be eligible for Cat of the Year awards an exhibit must be in the continuous ownership of a financial member throughout the year. Points are awarded based on the Top Five results at a show –

1st – 10 pts; 2nd – 7 pts; 3rd - 4 pts; 4th – 2 pts; 5th – 1 pt.

Note 1 - Where an owner becomes a member after the start of a calendar year, points will only accumulate from the date the membership application is processed by the office.

Note 2 - If during the year a cat is transferred to a new owner who is not a member, the cat's ownership by a financial member will be deemed continuous provided a membership application from the new owner is received and recorded by the office within 4 weeks of the date of transfer otherwise note 1 shall apply.

CAGES:

At this show, we will be allowing owner's cages but exhibitors must provide the dimensions of these cages with their entry. Please state clearly the dimensions (width, depth, height) of cages. **Maximum allowable dimensions shall be 76cm wide x 53cm deep x 61cm high (30"x 21" x 24")**. The cage must be either all metal, wire construction or sturdy cardboard on 3 sides with wire door or top.

SHOW CURTAINS AND BASE, LITTER TRAYS, AND WATER BOWLS

White or coloured fabric curtains and a base are permitted.

Curtains with lace or gauze frills are not permitted during judging.

Igloo type bases are not permitted during judging. Donut type bases are permitted.

Pillow slip base covers shall be sealed at the ends so that a cat cannot get inside the cover.

Any coloured plastic litter tray is permitted in cages during judging.

Any colour plastic or stainless steel clip-on water bowls attached to the front or door of the cage are permitted.

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES:

Methylated spirits, bleach, atomisers and aerosol sprays are not permitted in the show hall. Dettol and similar coal tar derivatives are not to be used as disinfectants. Talcum powder or any similar substance may not be applied to or brushed from an exhibit while in vicinity of the cages in the show hall.
