## Pedigree Groups

Top 5 placings will be awarded in Male Kitten, Female Kitten, Desexed Kitten, Male Cat, Female Cat, Neuter Cat and Spay Cat in all three rings.

## Companion Group

Top 5 placings will be awarded in Desexed Kittens, Neuter Cats and Spay Cats in all three rings.

Top 10 Kittens & Cats/Desexed – Each judge in Rings 1, 2 and 3 will pick their Best Male Kitten, Female Kitten, Desexed kitten, Male Cat, Female Cat, Neuter Cat and Spay cat and these will be eligible for Top 10 judging.

Supreme Companion – Each judge in Rings 1, 2 and 3 will pick their Best Exhibit and these will be eligible for Supreme Companion.

Top 5 Forest Cats and Kittens – Penny Bydlinski will choose her Top 5 Cats and Top 5 Kittens for this Specialty Ring.

Forest Cat Challenge Ring – This is a specialist ring for Forest Cat Breeds only. To be eligible to enter this Ring, each Exhibit must be entered in the Main Show as it is a Challenge Award Ring.

## Our Judges' Profiles

Valerie Cashman - Retired breeder of Burmese



under the prefix of "Aurora" with success on the show scene in Australia, Europe, Poland, Russia, South Africa, Canada, USA and New Zealand. My love of Burmese started about 33 years ago with a rescue cat in Sydney. I have held

numerous positions of office within the cat fancy in Queensland, including Registrar and Secretarial duties during which time I set up a large database using Fife EMS codes for one council. I was President of The Burmese Cat Society Of Qld (a QFA affiliated club) for many years. I am interested in cat welfare, and was a committee member in 2009 for fundraising for Native Wildlife injured and displaced by Australia's worst bushfires. I enjoy Judging and was privileged to be judging at the ACF National in Hobart 2007, and in five Australian states, the Northern Territory and for several Clubs in NZ. I was a member of The Gold Coast Cat Club for 19 years and was Secretary for that club for a while.

Fiona Mangan - Animals have always been



important in my life. After growing up with the company of whippets, greyhounds and a succession of cats of varying descriptions, I became interested in cats in a serious way after forming a liaison with my first Abyssinians, a tawny and a silver, in

1989. Initially, it was just an involvement in showing cats. Breeding them soon followed, specialising in Silver Abyssinians under the Nivalis prefix. Today, we have a multi-cat household, each of them allotted time according to their need to love and be loved. All cats are special and each is unique, regardless of their ancestry. I am a member of several cat clubs and have, for many years, been actively involved with the Abyssinian Cat Club of Australasia serving in roles including President, Secretary, Treasurer and Show Manager. Since 1998 I have been active as a steward, enjoying assignments in all groups. In 2003, I qualified as a Companion Exhibit Judge. My pedigreed judging experience began with Group 3 (full licence 2010), followed by Group 2 in 2013, attaining my Shorthair Judge's licence. In 2016, I was completed my Longhair licence (Group 1) and am now fully licenced as an All Breeds Judge. Currently residing in the Hunter Valley Wine Country region of NSW, I enjoy observing and learning about our local wildlife. Apart from my strong interest in all things feline, other interests include zoology, reading, embroidery, and quilting.

Maureen Norberry - I became involved with cats



and the Cat Fancy by accident about 18 years ago with the gift of a tiny seal point Siamese kitten who became the mother of my first "show" kitten – a blue point

Siamese. Since that first show I

have been actively involved with the Cat Fancy as a breeder (chiefly Orientals and Siamese but also briefly Devon Rex), exhibitor and worker – being regularly involved in the running of shows and assisting on the executive of a number of Clubs. I am currently the Secretary of the Oriental Cat Club of NSW and President of St George District Cat Club and hold Life Membership with both those clubs. I commenced judging with Group 2 (1996), followed by Group 3 (1998) and in 2005 I completed my Group 1 training. As of 1 January 2007 I will be a fully licensed Allbreeds judge. I have enjoyed immensely judging in most states of Australia and in the North and South Islands of New Zealand. In my other life I am a solicitor with my own practice in the small regional town of Mittagong. In my rare moments of spare time I enjoy exploring antique shops, gardening, reading and learning about one of my other great hobbies – marine and tropical fish.

Sharon Hodge - I have been involved in the cat fancy since approximately 1986.



During that time my husband and I have bred and shown Persians and Exotics (solids, colourpoints and bi-colours). During this period of time were regular exhibitors at shows, except for a period where I took a brief hiatus to study law. We both

feel blessed that we were able to enjoy some success on the show bench with our breeding. With my husband and children I have donated time working at and supporting cat shows in a variety ways. Not only have I had the joy sharing my life and home with Persians and Exotics but currently enjoy the pleasure of the company of a Siberian and a Bengal. I have held a number of positions in cat clubs over the years and I presently hold the position of President of the Longhair Cat Association of NSW. In 2008 I attained my Group 1 Licence and in March 2015 I was granted was granted Group 1 Tutor Judge status. In March 2015 I also attained my Probationary Group 2 and Group 3 Judge's Licence, and will be an All Breeds Judge upon the completion of the probationary period.

Christine Tomlinson - I have always had a love



affair with cats for as long as I can remember and would always befriend any cat I came across. I got my first pedigree cat in 1977 and started to show in 1978. He was a red point Siamese and this was the beginning of my involvement in the cat world.

Together with my husband Ray, an All Breeds Judge, we breed and show both Siamese and British shorthair under the Tomadah Prefix. We specialise in red, cream and tortie point Siamese which have taken out many Best In Show and Group 2 Cat of the Year Awards. We live in Griffith in the heart of the Murrumbidgee Irrigation Area and in 1982, with the help of others, were instrumental in the founding of the MIA Cat Club. For various periods over the years since then I have held the positions of President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Publicity Officer of the Club. I am an experienced Steward and completed the Companion Cat Judges Training Course in 1997 and since then have judged at many shows. I successfully completed the Group 2 Judges Training Course in 2001, obtaining my full Group 2 Licence on 1 July 2003.

Phillipa Perkins - I have been involved with the cat



fancy since 1988, when I first registered my breeding prefix "SINJIN" under which I have exclusively bred Siamese & Orientals and much to my delight achieved numerous Breeder/Owner Cat & Kitten of the Year awards over the

years. I'm a founding & life member of The Oriental Cat Club of NSW and have, over the years of my involvement with this club, held the positions of Treasurer, Show Manager and Show Secretary & I currently hold the position of President. I am also currently a member of the NSW CFA Management Committee. I became an approved steward in 1994 and then a NSW CFA Companion Judge in 1999. In March 2015 I successfully completed the NSW CFA All Shorthair Judges Training Course (Groups 2 & 3) and was granted a Probationary Shorthair judges licence. My love & admiration for all felines has given me enormous pleasure in my Companion judging and stewarding and I am looking forward to continuing that experience in judging and handling the amazing pedigree breeds of cat we have on the show bench. In my other life,... What other life?? .....The Cats Rule it!!



Penny Bydlinski was brought up in the United



Kingdom with cats of one sort or another but bought her first Burmese in Canada in the 1960s. She bred Burmese under her prefix of Penric from 1969 to 2007. She has also bred Persians and, together with her partner Roger, Abyssinians under the prefix Rydene. Although Burmese will always be her first love,

Abyssinians run a close second; it is a breed about which she feels very strongly. She qualified as a FIFe judge for shorthairs in 1981 and later for both the Longhair and Semi-longhair categories. She was on the FIFe board from 1993 until her retirement in 2005, having been General Secretary for 10 years. Penny has judged extensively all over Europe, South America, Indonesia and Malaysia, as well as in Australia and New Zealand. She was Chair of the first FIFe member in the UK and actively involved in its successor, serving on both the Show and the Judges Commission as well as being Chair, until her retirement in 1975, of the Garden of England Cat Club that she founded in 1991. Penny is now semi-retired and living high in the hinterland of the Gold Coast in Queensland. She is still Secretary of the World Cat Congress, a post she has occupied since 1995 and which she enjoys very much as it gives an opportunity for meeting and exchanging ideas with people from other organisations around the world. She now has more time to enjoy her hobbies of books, embroidery, theatre and gardening in the very beautiful surroundings where she lives with the company of her three cats, a black Exotic neuter, a brown Burmese neuter and, of course, an Abby neuter. In 2011, FCCQ invited Penny to become its first Honorary Judge and the Council was delighted when she accepted. Penny was presented with her FCCQ Honorary Judge badge at the October 2011 show and will be invited to judge on a regular basis.

## Exhibitor and Entry Requirements

### MEMBERSHIP STATUS:

All exhibitors resident in NSW must be current financial members of NSW CFA, or a financial member of ANCATS or Cats NSW. New exhibitors resident in NSW may show three times as non-members provided their exhibits are registered in their name. An exhibitor resident in another state must be a member of a controlling body recognised by CCCA or ACF and the exhibits must be registered in the exhibitor's name with that controlling body.

### ENTRIES:

All entries must be submitted on the official NSW CFA Entry Form together with a clear copy of each exhibit's registration certificate in the name of the exhibitor as owner. For interstate exhibitors where the registration certificate does not include a four generation pedigree, then a four generation pedigree must be provided showing the breeds and colours of all forebears.

### RETURNED CHEQUES:

Should any cheque be returned unpaid, a bank cheque or money order will be required to ensure that the entry is processed, and the costs incurred by NSW CFA Inc for the returned cheque shall be paid by the exhibitor, together with an additional \$20.00 for administrative costs.

### AMENDMENTS TO SEX/COLOUR/TITLES:

Any change to the sex or colour/pattern or the title of an exhibit after an entry has been lodged must be submitted in writing to the Show Secretary together with a copy of the amended Certificate of Registration no later than one week prior to the show date (see Show Procedure 5.11)

### CLAWS TO BE CLIPPED:

The front and back claws of each exhibit must be clipped.

### VETERINARY INSPECTION:

Each exhibit must be inspected by and pass the Veterinary Officer's inspection before being allowed to be benched in the show. Exhibitors are to handle their own cats at the vetting table.

### VACCINATION OF KITTENS:

All kittens must be vaccinated. Exhibitors must produce documentary evidence (valid vaccination certificate) for each kitten and a vaccination shall have been carried out by a qualified veterinary practitioner not less than 14 days prior to the date of the show (see Show Procedure 6.3)

### AGGRESSIVE EXHIBITS:

A Judge or Steward is not required to handle any exhibit showing signs of aggression. Owners have a duty of care not to bench any exhibit that has a reported history of fractious behaviour. The Show Manager and Show Committee in consultation with the Show Representative may require the removal of any such exhibit from the show.

### NSW CFA CAT/KITTEN OF THE YEAR AWARDS:

To be eligible for Cat of the Year award a cat must be in the continuous ownership of a financial member throughout the year. Note 1. Where an owner becomes a member after the start of a calendar year, points will only accumulate from the date the membership application is processed by the Office. Note 2. If during the year a cat is transferred to a new owner who is not a member, the cat's ownership by a financial member will be deemed continuous provided a membership application from the new owner is received and recorded by the Office within 4 weeks of the date of transfer, otherwise note 1 shall apply.

Litter Entries: at least one kitten from the litter is to be entered individually. Please also see the note on the Entry Form on how to enter a litter. Entry details for individually entered litter kittens must clearly show "LITTER KITTEN".

There will be no reduction in entry fees if fewer than 3 rings entered, except where an exhibit is ineligible for a ring under NSW CFA Show Procedures. Each exhibit will be automatically entered in the relevant age class for judging based on the information shown on the exhibit's Certificate of Registration & Pedigree.

PLEASE ENSURE ALL INFORMATION SHOWN ON YOUR EXHIBIT'S CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION & PEDIGREE IS UP TO DATE.

EXHIBITORS MAY PROVIDE THEIR OWN SHOW CAGE – please state OWN CAGE with dimensions.
